- Currently, Dean of Student Services is reviewing.


Both E-Learning Policies & Procedures will need to be endorsed and approved by University Cabinet, President, & Board of Regents.

Those that cannot see your courses, once you log into Moodle, under “My Courses”, scroll down. Look for SP17 which are the Spring 2017 courses.

The courses may be greyed. All courses will be activated on Tuesday, January 17th, when the semester starts. Faculty are able to log into their course and begin working on their content.

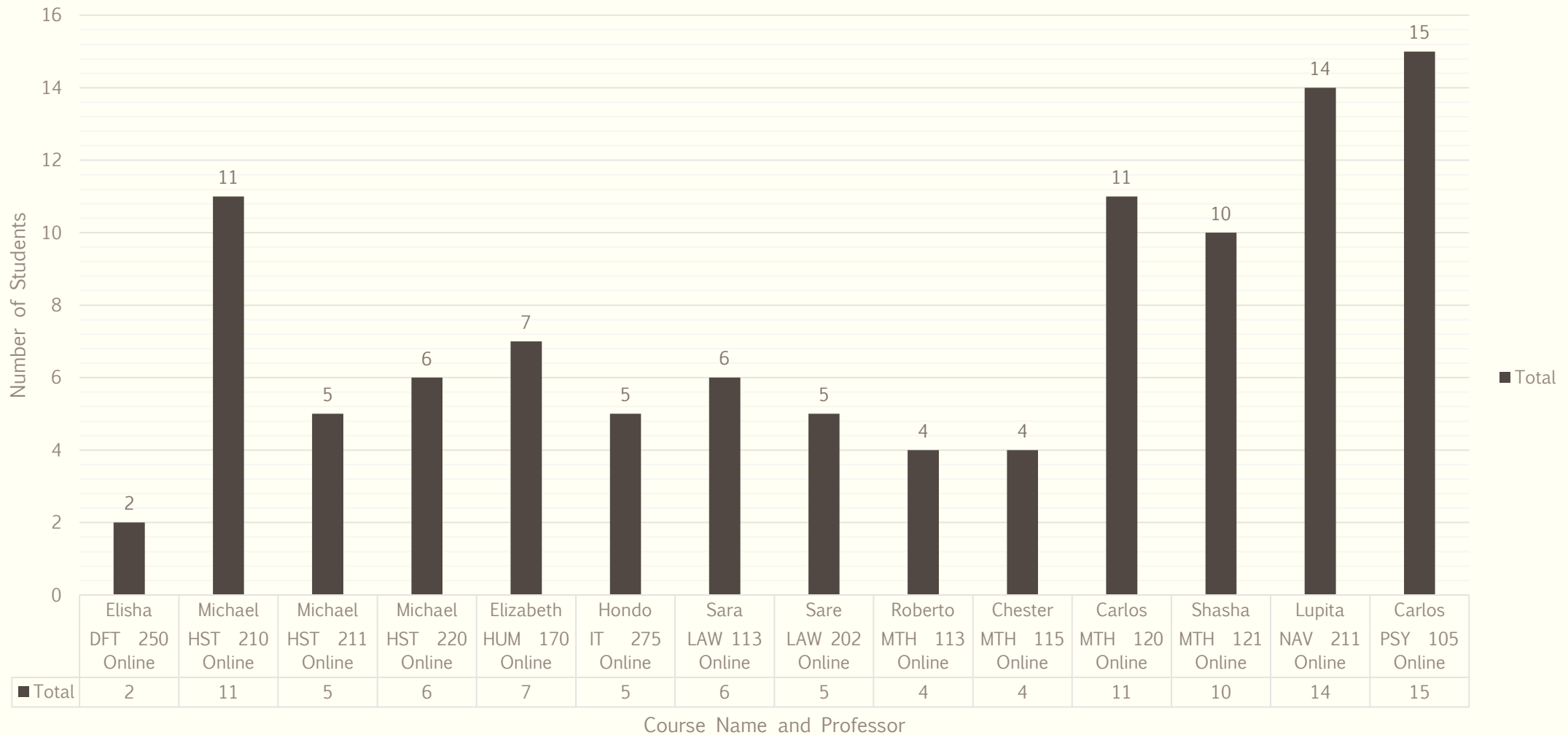

Spring 2017 Online Courses - Number of Enrollment

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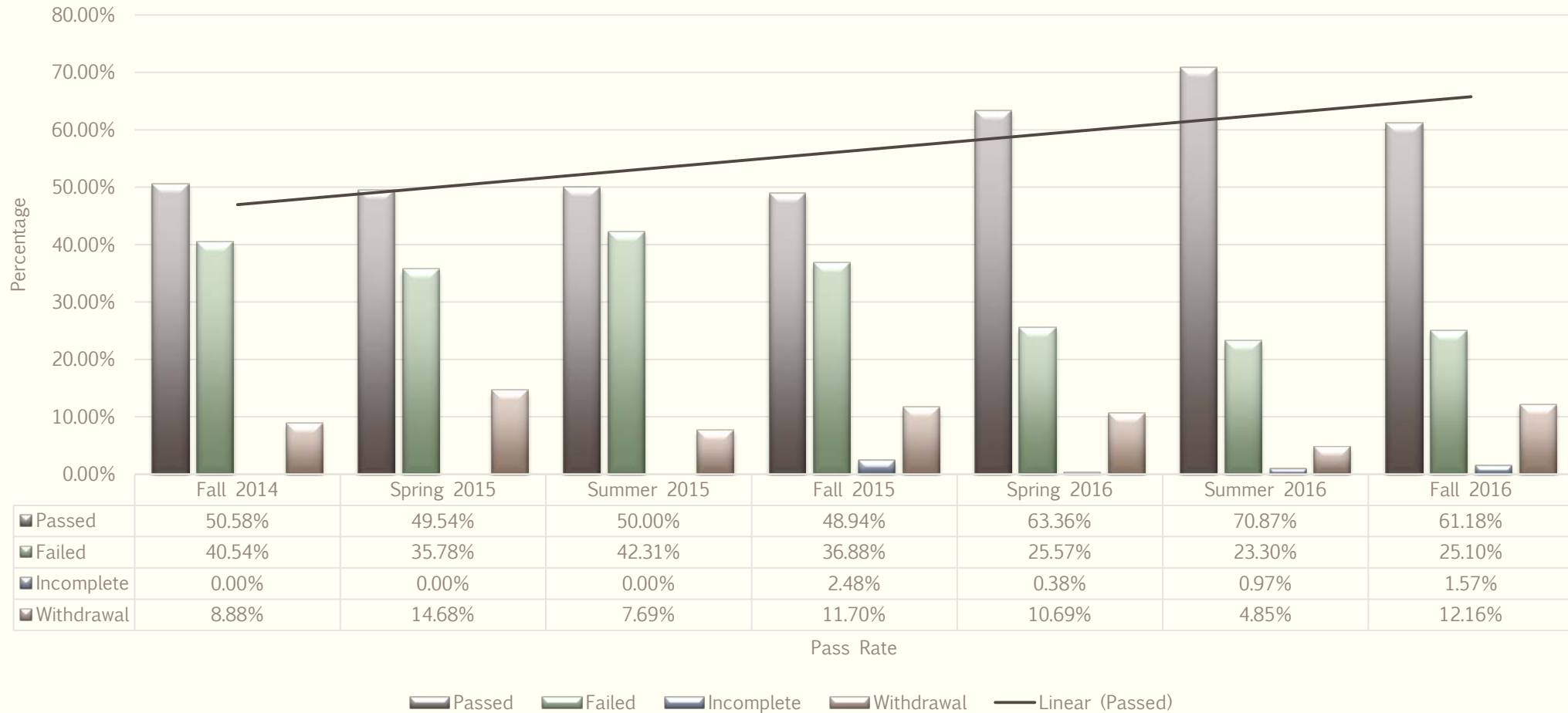

NTU Overall Online Course Rate from Fall 2014 to Fall 2016



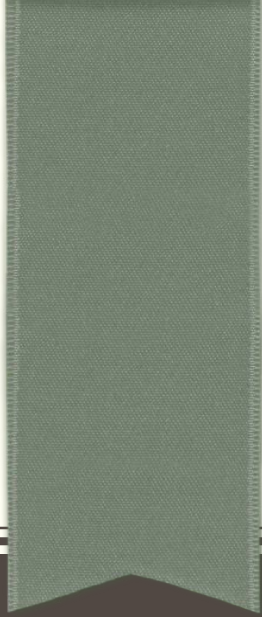
Working on for the Spring 2017 Semester
